- Q. Was that shortly after the accident happened?
- 3 A. Yes, that day.
- Q. And you provided them a written statement?
- 5 A. Yes, I did.
- 6 Q. Did you also provide them an oral statement?
- 7 A. Yes.
- Q. And were those both in the same session?
- 9 A. Yes. Yes, it was.
- 10 Q. Okay. So did they record a statement from
- 11 you and then take a written statement, or other way
- 12 around?
- 13 A. Oh, I don't recall which order.
- 14 Q. Okay. And those both happened like within
- 15 how many minutes of each other would you estimate?
- 16 A. A couple minutes.
- 17 Q. Have you seen your written statement since
- 18 you gave it?
- 19 A. Yes, I saw it.
- 20 Q. Is there anything you would change in the
- 21 written statement that wasn't accurate?
- 22 A. No.
- Q. In your statement do you recall saying that
- 24 she reached up with her left arm and grabbed her hair?
- 25 A. Yes.

- Q. And then you say you noticed her slide into
- 2 the water with the whale?
- 3 A. Yes.
- Q. So do you know why she was grabbing her hair?
- 5 A. Why she was grabbing her hair?
- 6 Q. Yeah.
- 7 A. Because that -- because the whale had sort of
- 8 either grabbed her hair or -- from my point of view
- 9 grabbed the hair, so she was grabbing the hair, just
- 10 trying to pull it off the whale.
- 11 Q. Pull it out of the whale's mouth?
- 12 A. Out of the whale, yes.
- 13 Q. Did you also give a statement where you said
- 14 the whale had grabbed her arm?
- A. Well, from my angle, it looked like, you
- 16 know, it grabbed her arm or the hair, either one of
- 17 them. That's why.
- 18 Q. Did you -- did you see when the whale grabbed
- 19 whatever it grabbed -- that is, did you see it grab her
- 20 arm or grab her hair?
- 21 A. Well, from my angle I saw the arm come up and
- 22 grab the hair. So if -- from my angle from where I was
- 23 sitting, I saw, you know, it could have been the arm or
- 24 the hair. So --
- 25 Q. Now, right before that happened, where was

- 1 statement that you would change?
- 2 A. No.
- 3 Q. You see that you wrote in there that: I did
- 4 observe Shamu trainer Dawn petting the whale named
- 5 Tilikum.
- 6 A. Yes.
- 7 Q. And then: At the concrete area of the pool
- 8 when the whale grabbed the trainer's arm and pulled her
- 9 into the pool and would not let go.
- 10 A. Right.
- 11 Q. Is that accurate?
- 12 A. Yes, it's accurate. I mean, whatever she was
- 13 -- whatever she was doing, he wouldn't let go. So if
- 14 she had her arm -- you know, by her hair and
- 15 everything, he wouldn't let go. And then that's when I
- 16 saw her going into the pool.
- Q. Okay. But here the statement says that the
- 18 whale grabbed the trainer's arm. Do you see that?
- 19 A. Okay.
- 20 Q. Do you disagree with what you wrote there,
- 21 the statement you gave to the sheriffs?
- 22 A. From -- from my angle, it seemed that, you
- 23 know, either her arm or her hair was grabbed. So from
- 24 my angle I saw the arm go up and then grabbed her hair.
- 25 But I assume he grabbed with the arm.
